IMPERFECTIONS ARE PART OF THE PROCESS

Slight imperfections are an inherent aspect of dye sublimation when using finished goods such as tee shirts, blankets, towels, etc. While Trevco takes great care to minimize these imperfections, we cannot eliminate them entirely. Here are some examples of what you might see.

FOLDS

- Folds present in the shirt during heat pressing will become permanent, allowing the white shirt to show through.
- Common areas: Arm pits, sleeves, shoulders and down the sides.

FADED SEAMS

- Due to the thickness of the material in these areas, some of the white shirt may show through on the seams of the shirt.
- Common areas: Arms, shoulders and possibly down the sides.

THE DYE SUBLIMATION PRINTING PROCESS CREATES SLIGHT IMPERFECTIONS OVER SEAMS AND/OR FOLDS AND ARE UNIQUE TO AND A PART OF EACH ITEM.
